**Limit: 15 students**

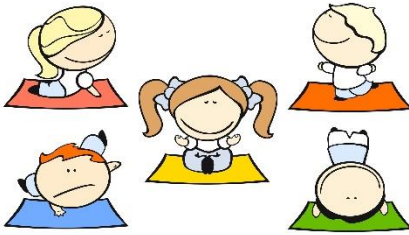

**Limit: 20 students**

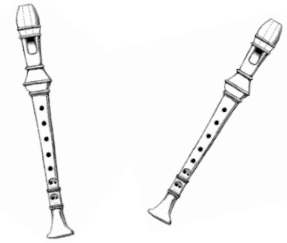
